

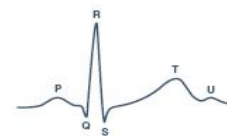

Basic ECG Interpretation and Nursing Management Course



Objectives:

1. To outline the causes of common dysrhythmias.
2. To interpret normal and abnormal ECG rhythms.
3. To identify appropriate nursing care to manage each discussed abnormal dysrhythmia.
4. To discuss common medical management for each discussed abnormal dysrhythmia.
5. To demonstrate confidence in caring clients with abnormal ECG.

Ms Jennifer Chan has more than ten years clinical experience in coronary care. She possesses the Certificate of Coronary Care Nursing and Cardiac Intensive Care Nursing from IANS. She has been a visiting lecturer giving lectures and presentation on coronary care at IANS, Hong Kong Critical Care Nurse Association, Association of Hong Kong Nursing Staff, and the 2nd Five-Continent International Symposium on Cardiovascular Disease at Beijing. Ms Chan presently works in the Matilda International Hospital as a Nurse Specialist (Acute Care) and she is the Chairman of CPR Committee in the same Hospital.
