## *Chinese Medicine for Maternity*

She is one of the apprentices of the famous Chinese medicine practitioner, 劉敏如國醫大師, of Tung Wah Hospital. Her foci are diagnosis and care of clients with gynaecological, thyroid gland, diabetes mellitus and respiratory disorders and she is responsible for the coordination work of the periodic breast pain management in the out-patient clinic.*

*Also, Ms. Wong is the committee member of the Registered Chinese Medicine Practitioners Association of the Republic of China, committee member of Gynecology Committee of World Federation Chinese Medicine Societies and Lecturer of Fundamental Chinese Medicine course.*

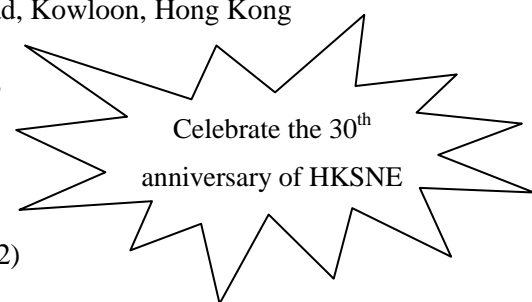
