Mr. Peter Lai is a Nurse Consultant. In his role, he oversees and leads intensive care and ECMO nursing services in a university-affiliated hospital. He is currently the Chair of the Education Committee of Asia-Pacific Extracorporeal Life Support Organization (AP-ELSO). He has presented broadly on intensive care nursing, Extracorporeal Membrane Oxygenation (ECMO) management, infection control and wound management topics in various international conferences in Asia, Europe and North America. His research and practice interest includes burn resuscitation, burn wound management, management of critically ill patients, ECMO nursing and use of simulation in nursing education.
