EWS2: Statistics Course 2024- for Health Care Professionals

Course information:

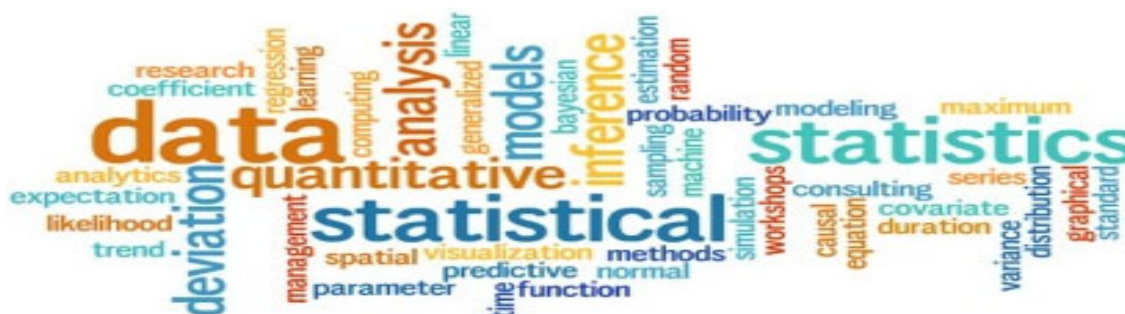
EWS5: Statistics course 2024 will have three sessions: (1) the first 3-hour session will cover the methods and considerations in identifying an appropriate statistical test for bivariate analysis (t-test, ANOVA, Mann Whitney test, Chi-squared test, and correlation coefficients); (2) the second 3-hour session will cover an intermediate level of basic concepts of a repeated measures design; and demonstrate “Restructuring data format” and introduce “Generalized Estimating Equations (GEE)” for common repeated measures designs in SPSS; and (3) the third 3-hour session will cover the overview of steps of systematic review in evidence-based nursing practice. In addition to narrative synthesis, the use of meta-analysis provides better understanding of the effectiveness of the intervention for clinical practice and research. This course is very practical for students who need to conduct systematic review or doing their final year project.

Speaker:

Dr. Doris Y.P. Leung, is an Associate Professor of the School of Nursing, The Hong Kong Polytechnic University.

Dr. Leung has substantial experience in teaching statistics, research method, and generation of evidence-based practice to students in health-related disciplines from undergraduate to doctorate levels for more than 10 years. She also conducts seminars on advanced statistical analysis and provide consultation in research design and statistics in proposal writing and manuscript preparation. She has over 100 publications in international peer- refereed journals with the h-index 35 and the g-index 58 in Scopus.

Dr. Alan H.L. Tam, is a Research Assistant Professor of the Nethersole School of Nursing, The Chinese University of Hong Kong. He is an emerging researcher actively participating in research and research training. He has substantial experience to synthesis evidence to inform practice. From 2021, he has published 7 review articles including systematic reviews and overview of systematic reviews in international peer-refereed journals.
